I'm not great at graphic design and tend to hire somebody for the final product, so don't judge that too harshly please. This file contains all the cards needed to play with up to eight people, the rules should be nearby to where ever you found this.

## What You'll Need.

9 tokens per player, they should be identifiable from all the other player's markers, Euro-cubes are ideal if you can find them in enough colours, and one playing piece or pawn per player.

A means of keeping score. The main rules will refer to a scoring track with meeples moving around it, but sets of D10 or a piece of paper will do fine so long as you remember to ignore the track references in the rules.
